Definitions:

"The club" refers to Falmouth Canoe Club, as governed by the committee of Falmouth Canoe Club. "The renter" refers to the individual who's details are on this form. "The rack" refers to the boat rack that has been allocated to the renter by the club. "Canoe" refers to an open canoe or kayak of a size and type agreed suitable for storage by the club.

The renter **MUST** be a current, paid-up member of the club.

The renter is entitled to store ONE canoe on the rack.

The renter is entitled to the use of the padlock and cable supplied with the rack.

The renter may store a different canoe in place of the one specified, but should notify the club if the change is expected to be permanent.

The renter must use the rack only in such a way that does not compromise the security or cause damage to other canoes stored.

The club accepts no responsibility for the safety or security of any canoes stored. The club recommends taking an appropriate insurance policy if you have concerns over the security of your equipment. See <http://www.canoe-england.org.uk/membership/boat-insurance/>.

If the renter plans to continue to rent the rack after the end of the rental period, a new application must be submitted in good time.

The club committee may request that the canoe is temporarily moved or removed for building or rack maintenance. In the case that the canoe is not moved as requested, the committee reserves the right to move the canoe themselves. The club does not accept responsibility for any damage to the canoe while this is done. In the case that the renter's membership of the club is terminated, the committee may also terminate this rental agreement without refund.
